Campers will have so much fun participating in leadership activities that they won't even realize they're sharpening their communication, confidence and collaboration skills.

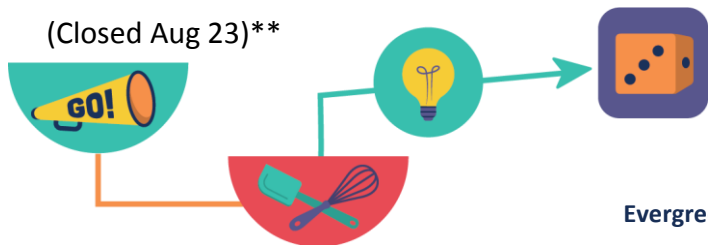
