


Star Student Schedule

Each child in our class will have the opportunity to be our “Star Student” for a week this year! The dates for all of the kids are listed at the end of the letter. I will be the model for the first week and then we will rotate randomly through the class. When possible, the dates coincide with birthdays or half-birthdays. If there is no school on one of the days, the Star Student sharing items can be doubled on another day.

As the Star Student, your child will be sharing a little something about him/herself each day. The schedule for the week is listed here:

Monday: The star student will share an autobiographical poster.

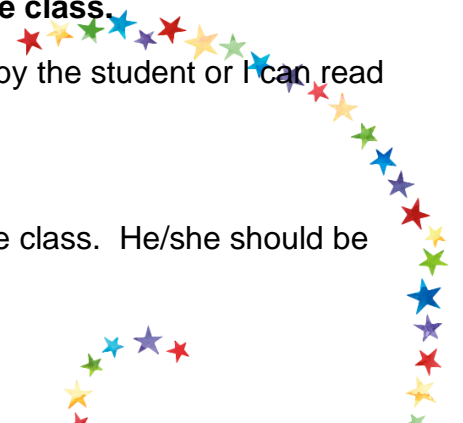
- ★ At home, create an “All About Me” poster together, highlighting some of your child’s interests. Use photographs, drawings, writing, etc. to help your child tell about him/herself. I have poster board at school that I can send home or you are welcome to come up with something on your own.
- ★ Your child will also get to bring home our class pet (a stuffed Raccoon named Chester) and a notebook. Throughout the week, your child may interact with him and write about their time together in the notebook. Both Chester and the book should be returned to school in the bag on the following Monday.

Tuesday: The star student will bring a favorite book to share with the class.

- ★ Help your child choose a book to read to the class. It can be read by the student or I can read it aloud.

Wednesday: The star student will share a favorite stuffed animal.

- ★ Help your child choose one special stuffed animal to share with the class. He/she should be prepared to tell three things about it.



Thursday: The star student will share a prized possession or favorite toy.

- ★ Help your child choose an item to share with the class. He/she should be prepared to tell three things about it.

Friday: Parents will send in a special letter that I can read to the class.

- ★ Please write a letter to the class about your child. In the letter, you can tell about some of your child's talents or favorite things, or anything else you would like to share. If you would like to join us for lunch (11:00) and read the letter yourself, we would be delighted.

Monday (following): The star student will bring back Chester's notebook to share with the class.

- ★ Help your child to write down some of his/her adventures with Chester throughout the week. Photographs of your child and Chester spending time together are always fun to see and can be glued right in the notebook.
