Each child in our class will have the opportunity to be our "Star Student" for a week this year! The dates are listed at the end of the page. When possible, the dates coincide with birthdays, half-birthdays, or near-birthdays. If there is no school on one of the days, the Star Student sharing items can be

doubled on another day. As the Star Student, your child will be sharing a little something about him/herself each day. The schedule for the week is listed here:

Monday: The star student will share an autobiographical poster.

• At home, create an "All About Me" poster together, highlighting some of your child's interests. Use photographs, drawings, writing, etc. to help your child tell about him/herself. I have poster board at school that I can send home, or you are welcome to come up with something on your own.

Tuesday: The star student will bring a favorite book to share with the class.

y the • Help your child choose a book to read to the class. It can be read by the student, or I can read it aloud.

Wednesday: The star student will share a favorite stuffed animal.

• Help your child choose one special stuffed animal to share with the class. He/she should be prepared to tell three things about it.

Thursday: The star student will share a prized possession or favorite toy.

• Help your child choose an item to share with the class. He/sheeshould be prepared to tell three things about it.

Friday: Parents will send in a special letter that I can read to the class.

• Please write a letter to the class about your child. In the letter, you can talk about some of your child's talents or favorite things, or anything else you would like to share. You can send it with your child or email it to me by Friday morning.

Class Pet: The star student will share adventures with Murphy (a stuffed moose that lives in our classroom).

• On Monday, your child will also get to bring home our class pet (a stuffed moose named Murphy) and a notebook. Throughout the week, your child may interact with him and write about their time together in the notebook. Both Murphy and the book should be returned to school in the bag on Friday, when your child will share their adventures with the class.

• You are welcome to send treats to share with the class for your child's birthday or half-birthday. Please make sure it is something that is nut-free and easy to serve (ex. cupcakes, donuts, cookies). We will help the birthday child celebrate by singing a song and playing a game together.
